**Day 1 – Tuesday, July 27, 2010 – Flight from Providence, RI to ANCHORAGE, ALASKA:**

Transfer from Club to airport for flight to **Anchorage, Alaska**. We arrive **Anchorage** for our Hotel transfer to the recently-built Crowne Plaza Midtown (907-433-4104) for our 2 night accommodations. A Group Dinner Buffet is scheduled and included this evening. (Dinner)

**Day 2 – Wednesday, July 28, 2010 – Tour and Attractions in ANCHORAGE:**

After our Hotel breakfast, we depart for a City Tour w/ lunch stop (on own) at the Anchorage Museum. The Native Heritage Center, offering shows/movies/exhibits, will follow. A Group dinner is reserved at the Sour Dough Mining Co Restaurant. (B/tour/Attractions/Dinner)

**Day 3 – Thursday, July 29, 2010 – Anchorage to Denali via Denali Star Train (GoldStar Class):**

We depart from our Hotel to the Train Depot to board the **Denali Star** (Goldstar Class/offering Full Dining Service aboard, on own) for a full day of sightseeing en route to our accommodations at the **Denali Princess Wilderness Lodge** (907-683-2282). We are reserved for a rollicking Dinner show at the “**Denali Cabin Nite Dinner Theater**”. (B/Gold Star Class Train/Dinner Show)

**Day 4 – Friday, July 30, 2010 – DENALI Natural History Tour/Talkeetna:**

An early morning departure by bus is scheduled for our 5 hr **DENALI Natural History Guided tour** through highlights of this 6 million acre wilderness, watching for Mt. McKinley views as you learn about the park. Our chartered Coach will be waiting at our Hotel for departure to **Talkeetna**; a well-preserved reminder of Alaska’s past. Hotel Shuttle will provide local restaurant dinner options. (Snack/Dinner Allowance)

**Day 5 – Saturday, July 31, 2010 – Talkeetna to WHITTIER to M/S Coral Princess:**

After our Hotel Breakfast, we will board a Privately-Chartered Coach for a guided tour/transfer to the port of Whittier for embarkation aboard the **M/S CORAL PRINCESS** for your 7 night luxury cruise. Lunch stop will be at downtown Anchorage Saturday Market. (B/Tour/D)

**Day 6 – Sunday, August 1, 2010 – CRUISING HUBBARD GLACIER:**

Enjoy your day of cruising at leisure, to include afternoon scenic cruising of the The Hubbard Glacier. (B/L/D)

**Day 7 – Monday, August 2, 2010 – CRUISING GLACIER BAY NATIONAL PARK:**

**GLACIER BAY NATIONAL PARK** -The highest concentration of tidewater glaciers on the planet can be found at Glacier Bay National Park and Preserve. Access to this natural wonderland is extremely limited and not all cruise lines can offer this highlight. **Day 8 – Tuesday, August 3, 2010 – Full day and Evening in SKAGWAY:**

This "Gateway to the Klondike" watched as countless fortune-seekers passed on its streets as they headed to the Chilkoot and White Pass Trails during the heyday of Alaska's Gold Rush. **Day 9 – Wednesday, August 4, 2010 – Full Day in JUNEAU:**

Perched on a thin strip of land at the mouth of Gold Creek, Juneau is arguably one of America's most beautiful state capitals, with the looming summits of Mt. Juneau and Mt. Roberts providing a gorgeous backdrop. (Side tours are optional and not included) (B/L/D)

**Day 10 – Thursday, August 5, 2010 – Full Day in KETCHIKAN:**

This southern-most Alaskan port of call is known as "Alaska's First City" because it's the first major community travelers come to as they travel north. Founded as a fishing camp, Ketchikan is built on steep hillsides and is billed as the salmon capital of the world. A quaint village, the town is just three miles long and three blocks wide. With the world's largest collection of totem poles, Totem Bight State Historical Park offers insight into various native cultures of the Pacific Northwest. (Side tours are optional and not included) (B/L/D)

**Day 11 – Friday, August 6, 2010 – INSIDE PASSAGE (CRUISING):**

Spend the day at leisure, as we cruise the World-Renowned **Inside Passage**. The Scenery will be spectacular. (B/L/D)

**Day 12 – Saturday, August 7, 2010 – VANCOUVER, BC:**
