MACKINAC HIGHLIGHTS



Day 1- Wednesday- Sept. 8, 2010
 TBA - morning pick-up at your respective club. Transfer to Logan Airport. Arrive in Chicago in the early morning where you will board your 56 pax luxury motor coach for our trip to Frankenmuth, known as "Michigan's Little Bavaria" and our hotel for the next two nights. Dinner is at 6:30 P.M. tonight in the Bavarian Inn Restaurant with German entertainment. Our hotel is the Bavarian Lodge & Conference Center in downtown Frankenmuth across the wooden covered bridge (989-652-7200). (Dinner/Entertainment)

Day 2- Thursday- Sept. 9, 2010
 A buffet breakfast is at our hotel this morning. After breakfast, we'll enjoy a guided sightseeing tour of Frankenmuth City. Before returning to our hotel mid-afternoon, visit Bronner's Christmas Shop specializing in one of a kind ornaments and gifts. We'll partake in a strudel making experience upon arriving back at our hotel. Before dinner tonight, sample three German wines with cheese and crackers. Tonight, a group dinner is scheduled at the Bavarian Inn Restaurant right at our hotel. (Breakfast Buffet/Tour/Wine Sampling/Dinner)

Day 3- Friday- Sept. 10, 2010
 Luggage is out before breakfast. After a full buffet breakfast this morning, we depart to quaint Mackinaw City for a two night stay. Our hotel, the Best Western Dockside Waterfront Inn (231-436-5001) is located on 300 feet of sandy beach in the downtown shopping district of Mackinaw City. En-route, we'll make a luncheon stop on your own. Dinner this evening is a beachfront barbecue and bonfire right at our hotel. (Buffet Breakfast/Dinner)

Day 4- Saturday- Sept. 11, 2010
 After a hot breakfast, we depart to board the ferry for a full day on Mackinac Island, a charming Victorian island where "Somewhere in Time" was filmed. A scenic horse drawn carriage tour of entire Mackinac is included. We'll see such sights as Fort Mackinac, Arch Rock, Skull Cave, and more. The tour ends at the elegant Grand Hotel where we'll lunch on an elaborate feast and rock on the longest porch in the world. Depart Mackinac

Island late afternoon and return to our hotel. Enjoy time on your own tonight to explore Mackinaw City. Dinner is on your own tonight. (Breakfast/Ferry/Tour & Attractions/Lunch)

Day 5- Sunday- Sept. 12, 2010
 Luggage is out before breakfast for an early departure. We depart for Green Bay, Wisconsin for one night. A luncheon stop on your own is planned. A narrated scenic trolley tour of beautiful Door County Wisconsin is scheduled. We'll take an "Old Time" Trolley ride and see breathtaking vistas from Door County's scenic bluffs overlooking the islands.
