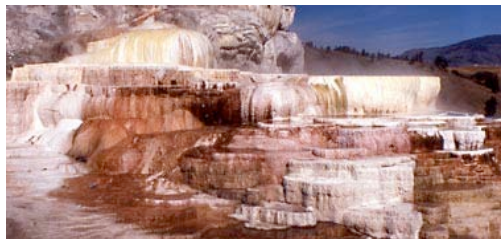

Day 1: Thursday, Sept. 16, 2010 - Providence / Denver / Cheyenne, Wyoming:

TBA - Morning pick-up is at your respective clubs with transfers to *TF Green Airport*. Arrive in *Denver* and meet our luxury motorcoach and step-on guide as we travel to *Cheyenne, WY*. We will overnight at the *Fairfield by Marriott Cheyenne* (307-637-4070). Tonight's dinner buffet is at *Ryan's Grill, Buffet and Bakery*. (Dinner Buffet)

Days 2: Friday, Sept. 17, 2010 - Mt. Rushmore/Keystone, South Dakota:

Put luggage out before breakfast. Enjoy breakfast at our hotel. After breakfast, we depart for *Keystone, South Dakota* for two days. A luncheon stop (on own) is planned. Our next two nights' accommodations are at the *Mt. Rushmore's White House Resort* (800-504-3210). This evening, we are reserved at *Flying T. Chuckwagon Supper Show*, and then the night illumination of *Mt. Rushmore*. (Continental Breakfast/Attraction/Dinner Show)

Days 3: Saturday, Sept. 18, 2010 - Black Hills/Mt. Rushmore/Crazy Horse Monument, SD:

Breakfast is at our hotel before departing for *Borglume Historical Museum & Mt. Rushmore*. We board the *Hill City 1880 Train* at 1:00 P.M. for a 2-hour one-way ride with lunch through the Black Hills to *Keystone*. Depart for *Crazy Horse Monument*. Afterwards, enjoy a dinner allowance in the *Keystone* area. (Buffet Breakfast/Train/Lunch/Attractions/Dinner Allowance)

Day 4: Sunday, Sept. 19, 2010 – Deadwood/Devil’s Tower/Sheridan, Wyoming:

Put luggage out before breakfast. After breakfast, we depart for *Deadwood, South Dakota* for a guided-tour and a luncheon stop (on your own) on *Deadwood’s* authentic *Old Western Main Street*. You’ll receive a coupon book for *Kevin Costner’s Morning Star Hotel*. En-route to our hotel, the *Sheridan Holiday Inn & Atrium* (307-672-8931), we will stop at the “*Devil’s Tower Monument*” (a film location for the blockbuster “*Close Encounters*”). We will cross the *Black Hills Region of South Dakota*, territory of the *Great Sioux Indian Nation*. A dinner allowance will be given for this evening.

Day 5: Monday, Sept. 20, 2010 – Cody, Wyoming/Yellowstone Park, Montana:

Breakfast is offered this morning within our hotel. Put luggage out before breakfast. Today’s travel includes the *Big Horn Mountains*. Lunch stop is on your own in *Cody, Wyoming*, home of *Buffalo Bill Cody*. Continue through the prairies and motor along *Lake Yellowstone* through the *Sylvane Pass* before arriving at our final destination, *West Yellowstone, Montana*, “*the Gateway to Yellowstone National Park*”. Our accommodations for the next 2 nights are at the *Yellowstone Lodge*. A dinner allowance will be provided for your choice of restaurants.

Day 6: Tuesday, Sept. 21, 2010 – Yellowstone National Park:

Breakfast is included in our hotel. Depart hotel to explore *Yellowstone National Park*. Today’s attractions include *Old Faithful, Fountain Paint Pots, the Yellowstone Falls and Canyon*. Return to our hotel. Tonight, we enjoy a group dinner at *Trappers Family Restaurant* in *West Yellowstone Park*.

Day 7: Wednesday, Sept. 22, 2010 – Grand Tetons / Jackson Hole:

Put luggage out prior to your breakfast in our hotel this morning. Depart for *Grand Tetons National Park*, the youngest mountains on our continent. Our accommodations this evening are at the *Painted Buffalo Hotel* (800-288-3866). This evening, you’ll experience the thrill of an authentic *Chuckwagon Ride* to the *Bar “T” Western Dinner Show*.

Day 8: Thursday, Sept. 23, 2010 – Salt Lake City – Utah:

Put luggage out before breakfast. After breakfast, we travel southward to *Bear Lake Summit* and follow the *Oregon Trail* passing through several *Mormon* cities. We then make our way to the “*City of Saints*”, *Salt Lake City, Utah*. Accommodations for tonight will be at the *Embassy Suites* (801-359-7800). This evening, dinner is scheduled at *Brigham Young’s Historic Home, The Lion House Pantry*.

Day 9: Friday, Sept. 24, 2010– Bryce Canyon:

Put luggage out before breakfast. After a full breakfast this morning, we will depart our hotel for *Bryce Canyon National Park*. It took many millions of years to carve these beautiful orange colored sandstone formations. Our hotel this evening is the *Best Western Ruby Inn* (800-468-8660). This evening a dinner buffet is included at our hotel.

Day 10: Saturday, Sept. 25, 2010 – Zion Canyon / Lake Powell:

A full breakfast is included for this morning. We depart for *Zion Canyon* for viewing some of the deepest and narrowest canyons in the world. Our adventure to *Lake Powell* takes us to *Kanab* in southern *Utah*, a region of exceptional scenery. Hundreds of movies and many TV episodes have been filmed here. We will be making a stop at *Glen Canyon Dam and Visitor Center*. This evening, we will enjoy a *Sunset Dinner Cruise* on *Lake Powell* featuring a prime rib dinner. Our hotel for this evening is the *Best Western Arizona Inn* (928-645-2466).

Day 11: Sunday, Sept. 26, 2010 – Grand Canyon:

Put luggage out before breakfast. Breakfast is planned for this morning before departing the hotel. Today, we make our way to the awesome *Grand Canyon National Park*. We will travel through the great *Navajo Nation Territory* and part of the *Painted Desert* as we make our way to the south rim of the *Grand Canyon*. The *Grand Canyon* extends 217 miles long and 8 miles wide. An early afternoon arrival allows time to participate in nature walks along the rim, or enjoy free shuttles for sunset viewing. This evening, your accommodations are at the *Holiday Inn Express Hotel/Suites Grand Canyon* (928-638-3000) at the *Canyon’s South Rim Entrance*. A dinner allowance will be provided.

Days 12 & 13: Monday & Tuesday – Sept. 27-28, 2010 – Las Vegas, Nevada:

After our hotel breakfast, we begin our drive to *Vegas*, “the city that never sleeps”. En-route, we will pass thru *Kingman, AZ*. We cross the *Colorado River* and make a lunch stop (on own) in *Laughlin, NV*. Our home for our final 2 nights together is at the amazing *Monte Carlo Hotel & Casino* (888-529-4828). Your accommodations include 2 buffet breakfast coupons. Enjoy ample leisure time to explore this exciting city and try your luck at the various hotels and casinos.

Day 14: Wednesday – Sept. 29, 2010 – Return Flight Home to Providence, RI:

Put luggage out before breakfast. Breakfast is in our hotel this morning. Depart hotel for *Las Vegas Airport* for our return flight home. Transfers to respective clubs will be provided.
